

2011 Calendar Deadlines

1. 2011 Draft calendar sent out to clubs to check – February 6th
2. Deadline for clubs to relinquish current dates, or inform the Calendar subcommittee of any errors – March 15th

This means if your club no longer wants a date that you held in 2010 you need to let us know that you no longer want this date. If there is a mistake in the calendar (for instance your traditional date has been left off or put on the incorrect week), you must also let us know by this date. After this date it is too late for any changes to be made.

3. Free dates announced to clubs – March 16th

A second draft will be published on this date. From this date your club can apply for any free dates available on the first second draft

4. Deadline for clubs to apply for free dates – April 30th

After this date clubs will be informed if another club within an influential distance, has asked for the same date. Further information will be gathered by the Calendar subcommittee to help with it's decision on which club will be allocated the free date.

5. Calendar subcommittee makes final decision on any dates more than one club has asked for – May 31st

Successful and unsuccessful clubs will be informed on this date. Unsuccessful clubs will be offered an alternative free date.

6. Deadline for unsuccessful clubs to accept any offered alternative date – June 15th

This is the last chance for unsuccessful clubs to have first option on free dates.

7. Final calendar confirmed – July 1st

The final confirmed calendar will be sent to clubs and put on the dogagility website on this date.

8. Free dates requests open – June 2nd

Any free dates on the Final calendar can be applied for by any club on a first come first served basis from this date. Free dates can be applied for at any time throughout the year.
