

A step by step guide to entering competitions.

All Shows (Ribbon Trials and Championship Shows) Agility, Jumpers, and Games

1 Get a permanent number

www.dogagility.org.nz/register.html

You will be allocated a number starting with 1 or 2 letters, based on the year of your dog's birth, and followed by 3 digits based on your dog's height. (AA123) This is the number you will use on the day for recording your results, and this number will stay with your dog forever.

2 Get your dog measured

Dogs must be measured no earlier than four weeks before they turn 18 months old, and two weeks before turning 2 years old.

You will need to complete step 1 prior to getting your measure also.

3 Enter your first Ribbon Trial

You are now ready to enter Ribbon Trials. Have a look on the agility calendar to see when there are upcoming shows you can enter.

If you are wanting to enter champ shows you will also need to follow steps 4, 5, and 6.

4 Join a club

You must be a member of a Dogs NZ affiliated club to enter champs shows. This could be a breed club or dog training club.

5 Join Dogs NZ

Membership numbers are 6 digits long and start with 0 or 1.

All owners and handlers of the dog must be financial members of Dogs NZ. The owner(s) refers to the person(s) who are listed as the owners on the Dogs NZ registration - this has nothing to do with the dogs local council registration.

6 Register your dog with Dogs NZ

Pedigree dogs are given a registration number that is 5 digits followed by the year of registration (12345-2023). Non pedigree dogs are given a number starting with OB/ followed by 4 digits (OB/1234)
